

- Article I. Club Identification
- Section 1.01 The club name shall be Oregon Scuba.
- Section 1.02 The club newsletter shall be Narcosis News.
- Article II. Statement of Club Purpose
- Section 2.01 To promote safe SCUBA diving activities.
- Section 2.02 To facilitate and promote diving conversation amongst the Oregon dive community.
- Section 2.03 To inform membership of legislation.
- Section 2.04 To promote dive safety education.
- Section 2.05 To promote habitat conservation through diving skill improvement and education.
- Section 2.06 Mentor new divers and new divers to the area
- Article III. Club Affiliation

Section 3.01 Oregon Scuba is a resource for all members of the Oregon diving community supported by its membership base.

Section 3.02 Oregon Scuba is not affiliated with any business but considers SCUBA industry business as equal partners in the promotion of the sport of SCUBA diving



Article IV. Membership

Section 4.01 Requirements

(a) Each member and participating family member shall complete and sign a liability waiver to be submitted along with a completed membership application.

Section 4.02 Membership Classification:

- (a) Full Member
  - (i) Must be a certified SCUBA diver or pursuing diving certification
  - (ii) Must fill out an application form, liability waiver, and member in good standing
- (b) Family Member
  - (i) Is applied only to members living in the same household.
  - (ii) Shall not scuba dive at club events unless he/she is a certified scuba diver.
- (iii) Shall be eligible for benefits equal to Full Member.
- (iv) Must fill out an application form, liability waiver, and member in good standing
- (c) Honorary Member
  - (i) Shall be proposed by a Club Member and approved by a majority vote of the club officers.
  - (ii) Shall receive all benefits of a Full Member.
- (iii) Shall not pay dues
- (iv) The status of an Honorary Member may be reviewed/renewed/revoked at intervals as deemed appropriate by the club officers.
- (v) Shall complete and sign an application form, and liability waiver upon being granted honorary membership





#### Section 4.03 Dues

- (a) These shall be payable in January of each New Year.
- (b) The amount of the dues shall be determined by the club officers. Changes in dues shall be approved by a 2/3 majority vote of the current members in attendance at a regular club meeting.
- (c) Members who have not renewed membership by the March meeting shall lose all Club privileges.
- (d) The categories of dues are: Full Membership and Family Membership.
- Article V. Club Officers and Club Management
- Section 5.01 Club Officer Conduct
  - (a) Shall at all times be responsive to the needs of the club membership in relation to the purpose of the club.
  - (b) Shall endeavor to conduct the business of the Club in the most efficient and responsible manner possible.
  - (c) Club meeting attendance is strongly recommended
  - (d) Club officer meeting attendance is strongly recommended
  - (e) Encourage increased participation of new divers in the local community.

Section 5.02 Club Officer Authority

- (a) Convene a committee of club members for the purpose of task or project completion
- (b) Collect new member dues, membership application and liability waiver and remit to treasurer
- (c) Convene an officers meeting for any purpose
- (d) Chair regular club meetings, in lieu of president and vice president
- (e) Administer the check out and check in of club owned equipment
- (f) Contribute regularly to newsletter Narcosis News



Section 5.03 Club Officer Positions & Responsibilities

- (a) Club President
  - (i) Shall preside over all club meetings and club officer meeting
  - (ii) Shall have been a club member for at least one year when nominated.
- (iii) Shall be responsible for ensure ongoing club solvency
- (iv) Shall be responsible for organizing the annual picnic & annual holiday party
- (v) Coordinate and facilitate club operation ensuring the success of club officers
- (vi) Assign officer temporary duties as needed
- (b) Club Vice President
  - (i) Shall act as President in the President's absence.
  - (ii) Shall be responsible for club monthly speaker and continuing dive education.
- (iii) Shall be responsible for club participation in community volunteer activities
- (c) Club Dive Coordinator
  - (i) Shall be the official club dive coordinator.
  - (ii) Shall maintain club owned diving equipment
- (iii) Shall maintain certification in the use of club owned diving equipment
- (iv) Coordinate dive hosts (dive sponsors)
- (v) Advertise approved host dives and sponsored dives
- (d) Club Dive Safety Officer
  - (i) Review and approve hosted and sponsor dive plans
  - (ii) Present safety topics or safety stories at club meetings
- (iii) Shall be alternate maintainer of club owned diving equipment
- (e) Club Secretary



- (i) Shall record the proceedings of the regular meetings.
- (f) Club Treasurer
  - (i) Shall conduct the financial affairs of the Club.
  - (ii) Shall be responsible for obtaining, storing and issuing air cards.
- (iii) Shall be responsible for issuing membership cards.
- (iv) Shall be responsible for maintaining membership list and contact details
- (v) Report at club meetings general financial and membership levels
- (vi) Report quarterly financials to club officers
- (g) Club Newsletter Editor
  - (i) Shall be the Newsletter Publisher-editor responsible for the assembly of officer and member articles as well as distribution of the newsletter.
- (h) Club Technology Officer
  - (i) Shall be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Club-sponsored Website.
  - (ii) Shall be responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Club-sponsored electronic communication and social media presence.
- (iii) Shall be responsible for making available to club membership and club officers access as deemed appropriate to club electronic resources

Section 5.04 Terms of Club Officer Service

- (a) Limits of Officer Service
  - (i) Shall be limited to two consecutive years in the same office for all officers
  - (ii) Shall last from January 1 through December 31.
- (iii) Any elected officer may step down from their elected position, remaining club officers will appoint replacement until next member election
- (iv) Any elected officer not fulfilling their roles and responsibilities may be removed by a majority vote of club officers
- (b) Elections



- (i) Elections will be held at November club meeting with responsibilities to begin in January.
- (ii) Nominations shall be at the October general club meeting one month prior to the election. Nominations will be accepted from the floor at that time.
- (c) Voting Procedure
  - (i) Elections shall be the privilege of all Members whose dues are paid in full at the time of voting.
  - (ii) Only those members present shall vote.
- (iii) The majority shall govern. In the case of a tie, the tossing of a coin shall be the final determining factor of the election.
- (d) Club Officers Meeting
  - (i) Only officers shall vote.
  - (ii) At least four Officers must be present to constitute a quorum and to conduct club business.
- (iii) Proposals may be made by any club member.
- (iv) Any club member may attend the officers meeting.
- (v) Approvals of proposals require a majority vote of the attending club officers.
- Article VI. Amendments to the Charter

Section 6.01 Officer Request for Change

- (a) Amendments to the charter shall be discussed and voted on at a scheduled club officers meeting for presentation to club membership.
- (b) Discussion on the amendment shall be taken up at the next general meeting and a vote will be taken at the second general meeting.
- (c) Passage will require a 2/3 vote of the attending members in good standing.

Section 6.02 Member Request for Change

(a) Club member in good standing may present an amendment to the club officers at the officers meeting.



- (b) Amendments to the charter shall be discussed and voted on at a scheduled club officers meeting for presentation to club membership.
- (c) Discussion on the amendment shall be taken up at the next general meeting and a vote will be taken at the second general meeting.
- (d) Passage will require a 2/3 vote of the attending members in good standing.
